- Catechists, aides, students and parents will use appropriate language and act respectfully towards each other in the classroom and on the grounds of all campuses including Brendan Hall (St. Rose Campus), St. Paul of the Cross, and St. Agnes.
- Being respectful includes, but is not limited to: think before you speak and before you do; staying focused in class and participating in discussions and classroom activities. Listening to the catechist/aide and other class members. Taking care of the classroom and the building and not using cell phones during class.
- For the safety of everyone on campus, the students are asked to follow the directions of the catechist, aides, snack parents, or the volunteer at the desk and Mrs. DeVito.

If the student is disrespectful to the catechist/aide or other class member, they will be spoken to by the catechist and will be given some instructions on how to improve their behavior. This will not be done to embarrass the student but to help encourage appropriate behavior in the classroom so that learning about our faith can be an enjoyable experience for everyone.

If the behavior continues to be a disruption to the classroom, the student will be asked to take some time out and will be escorted to the volunteer at the desk, or another location. The catechist will speak to the student about their behavior and will notify the parent of the inappropriate behavior when the child is picked up.

If the child continues to disrupt the classroom, Mrs. DeVito will schedule a meeting with the parent and child to discuss ways to improve the discipline issues. Ongoing discipline problems may result in a change in the Faith Formation or Confirmation program for the family.

Cell phones are not to be used during class time, unless otherwise instructed to do so. If a student takes out their cell phone to text, surf the web, or make a phone call, the catechist will take the phone until the end of class and will return it to the parent when the student is picked up.
