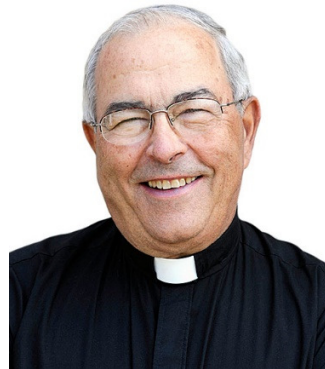




Father Lawrence Gross Memorial Fund
