PARISH OPERATIONS REPORT BONNIE DEPREZ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bonnie passed around a copy of her report. St. Agnes masonry project will resume in the spring, however, there is a lack of funds for the completion of this project. . Currently working on emergency response packets for each building. Each building should have an AED. St. Rose does not. . The stained glass window of the 3 churches has been evaluated by 1 company. The estimated cost for repairs is substantial. . St. Agnes School has a new sewer system. . There will be a Building and Grounds meeting in the spring to discuss upcoming building issues. . Purchasing has been streamlined by piggybacking with the Rochester School District with W.B.Mason. . Working with the collection handling procedure to remain audit compliant.
EXECUTIVE SESSION FATHER MICHAEL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> . Father reported on the last meeting with the Bishop. . The Bishop reflected on the Safe Environment training program. Everyone who interacts with children has to take these courses. . CMA – The Diocese as a whole is doing well. Our 3 parishes are possibly ahead of this time last year. . Discussed the state of Catholic Schools. St. Agnes last in Livingston County . 2 Clusters in danger of closing, Holy Ghost, St. Helen, Holy Family, and the ABC Cluster in the Southern Tier. . How do we get more people into the pews? A recommendation from the Men’s Group was for everyone to invite someone to come with them. . The first Men’s Group was 6 men. The next meeting will be at 8am at St. Paul of the Cross this Saturday
