PRAYER	Joshua Belokur led us in the opening prayer.
INTRODUCTION	Dan opened the June meeting of the Pastoral Council by asking if there were any corrections or additions to be made to the May minutes. Since there were only 3 persons present, that could not be an official meeting. Those there did have a discussion as per the May minutes. John made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Steve and accepted by those present.
EXECUTIVE SESSION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> . Dan distributed copies of the Diocese of Rochester Pastoral Council Guidelines and the Covenant of the Pastoral Council of St. Agnes, St. Paul of the Cross and St. Rose. He thanked the Buildings and Grounds Chairperson, the Finance representative and the principal of St. Agnes School for coming to the council and giving an annual report. . Father has spoken to an individual about becoming a member from St. Rose. She is considering this opportunity. . Dan suggested that since there was still a vacancy from St. Rose, and that it is now June, that the 3 members who should be going off the board should remain for another year. Father Michael offered an alternative suggestion. Each member of the current council should make every effort to find someone from their respective parish who would be willing to serve for a 3-year term. St. Rose would need another individual. These names would be submitted to Father who would then contact them and determine their commitment. If this process does not generate the required number of individuals, then the 3 incumbents would continue for another year.
PASTORAL update FATHER MICHAEL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> . Father attended convocation recently and felt that many of the current issues were addressed. . Father said that he is pleased that all 3 parishes reached their CMA goals this year. The 3 parishes should be in decent financial shape. St. Agnes School still has some issues. If gifts and donations continue, this may solve this problem. There are very few signed up for Kindergarten next year. If this does not change then the K will join with Pre-K 4. . Deacon William Goodman will be joining our group of parishes soon. . Fr. Edward Dillon of Geneseo will be residing at St. Mary's in Canandaigua. . The masonry work in Phase I of St. Agnes Church is progressing very well. We still need \$13,000 for Phase II which includes work on the body of the church? . There will be some changes at St. Paul of the Cross. Stay tuned.
OLD BUSINESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> . Ryne would like someone to volunteer to take over as the coordinator for the coffee hours at St. Rose and St. Agnes. St. Paul of the Cross is covered. . The Safety Awareness Program was tabled until September and Bonnie Deprez will be contacted to discuss this. There is information of the various bulletin boards. . Joan gave a brief overview of what has happened so far concerning the 150th Anniversary at St. Agnes. The updated history of the church is at the printer. The invitations are at the printers. Many of the pictures have been framed and are ready to be hung. We just need some time to gather the rest of the history to be displayed. Each room will feature a part of the history, Sisters of St. Joseph, priest and pastors, St. Agnes School and artifacts for the church itself. . Reception for those in the Music Ministries was tabled until September.
