PRAYER	Robert Alexander led us in the opening prayer.

St. Rose has one definite and Ryne Raffaele said that he would be willing to stay on another year. They would have three if Terry Hill agrees to be a representative. That would make the full complement of representatives.

Apparently Bonnie is the Safety Officer for all of the Parish Sites. The Parish Center has written a Disaster Plan for that site. . Music Ministry Reception was tabled until October.
